**CAST OF MGM'S UPCOMING FILM "HOT TUB TIME MACHINE" TO DONATE
\$10,000 TO THE 2010 MSP POLAR BEAR PLUNGE FOR SPECIAL OLYMPICS
MARYLAND**

**Charity Fundraiser on January 30th Expected to Raise \$3 Million
and Attract Over 25,000 People**

Baltimore, MD (January 22, 2010) – On January 30, 2010, three stars of MGM's upcoming film *HOT TUB TIME MACHINE* will be attending the 14th Annual Polar Bear Plunge in the Chesapeake Bay. They will be presenting a \$10,000 donation to the Special Olympics Maryland in the only way they see fit – in a hot tub! This charity fundraiser is expected to raise \$3 million for Special Olympics Maryland.

The stars from *HOT TUB TIME MACHINE* include Rob Corddry, formerly with "The Daily Show"; Craig Robinson, who plays Darryl Philbin on the award-winning show "The Office;" and Clark Duke from the hit show "Greek." After the Plunge, they will holding court in a hot tub in the Rams Head Ice Lodge for the check presentation, an autograph signing session, and other unexpected debauchery.

"We are thrilled to be joined at the 2010 MSP Polar Bear Plunge by the stars of *HOT TUB TIME MACHINE*," said Tom Schniedwind, Executive VP of Sports Marketing for Special Olympics Maryland. "What began 14 years ago as a small group of people doing something crazy has grown into an event that is attracting national attention and generating more enthusiasm and support for this important cause."

HOT TUB TIME MACHINE follows a group of best friends who've become bored with their adult lives: Adam (John Cusack) has been dumped by his girlfriend; Lou (Rob Corddry) is a party guy who can't find the party; Nick's (Craig Robinson) wife controls his every move; and video game-obsessed Jacob (Clark Duke) won't leave his basement. After a crazy night of drinking in a ski resort hot tub, the men wake up, heads pounding, in the year 1986. This is their chance to kick some past and change their futures – one will find a new love life, one will learn to stand up for himself with the ladies, one will find his mojo, and one will make sure he still exists!

Corddry, Robinson, and Duke will be joining Baltimore Ravens QB Joe Flacco, Governor O'Malley, and Olympic figure skater Kimmie Meissner in the Plunge. Other notable participants in past events, many of whom will be back again in 2010, include former Baltimore Ravens Assistant Head Coach Rex Ryan; Ravens players Adam Terry – OT and Haloti Ngata – DT;

Orioles Hall of Famer BJ Surhoff; former Raven Edwin Mulitalo; 98 Rock's Mickey, Amelia and Spiegel Morning Show, Stash, Theo and Sarah "The Queen" Fleisher; and former Governor Robert Ehrlich.

The Plunge is the Special Olympics Maryland's largest single-day fundraiser, grossing more than \$13 million in support of 10,000 Special Olympics Maryland athletes since its inception in 1997.

About Plungapalooza 2010

The featured event within Plungapalooza 2010 remains the ritual of the Plunge itself. Participants who have raised a minimum of \$50 will take a wintry dip into the Chesapeake Bay at either 1 p.m. or 3 p.m., some dipping just their toes, while others will completely submerge themselves in the icy waters. This year, as many as 18,000 people are expected to participate.

The day-long event has also grown into a "can't-miss" spectacle that includes much more than just the Plunge, and 2010 will be no exception. This year features the brand-new Rams Head Ice Lodge – a heated tent with live music all day beginning at 8 a.m. where those 21 and older can enjoy adult beverages. Plungers and spectators alike are also invited to enjoy the sights, sounds and smells of the boardwalk-themed festival tent – a huge, heated tent located on the grounds of Sandy Point State Park. Attractions include boardwalk-style games and displays, local and national vendors, live music and other entertainment, event merchandise sales, a Plunge Food Court, sandcastle building, wood carvings and a special area just for the kids with games, inflatables, face painting and more. Old favorites like the costume contest, live remote by 98 Rock, and the morning action at the Super Plunge Village will also be on the schedule. 2010 will also once again include the crowning of Miss and Little Miss Polar Bear Plunge and Miss Hypothermic Hon during the Polar Bear Plunge Pageant.
